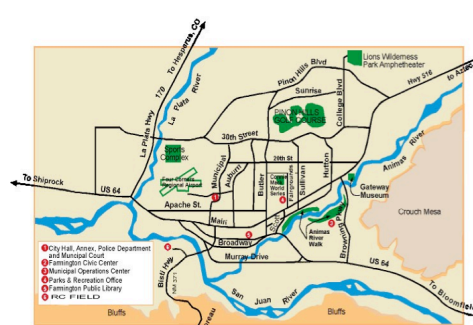
A radio control off road dirt track was added in 1997 and is maintained by the "Car" portion of our club.



## Where Do We Fly?

The Farmington R/C Park is located on Ojo Court which is off the Bisti Highway ( NM 371 ). Take Hwy. 371 south across the river to the end of the guard rails on the right, take the next right onto Ojo Ct. If you pass the concrete company you went past Ojo Ct.

## Map To The R/C Park



The R/C Park is located on OJO Court which is off Bisti Highway ( NM 371 ) just take 371 across the river and past Consolidated Constructors company, take the next right onto OJO. If you pass the Concrete company - you went past OJO. Go Back and turn left before Consolidated Constructors.

## When Do We Fly?

The Park is open for use during daylight hours 7 days a week. Peak flying times are weekends and mornings. We are an AMA club and follow AMA rules and safety guidelines.

## Learning To Fly

If you are interested in learning about R/C (cars or planes) the first thing you should do is NOT buy a Plane or CAR!!

Contact the club, and one of our instructors will guide you to the best choice for a beginner. Yes, that P51 Mustang is a beautiful plane and you are dying to fly one, but it is not the kind of plane that you should use when learning to fly.

Our instructors will help you choose a training plane and assist you with any building and prep work. They will then help with the necessary preflight system checks to avoid first flight crashes. You will then have numerous sessions with the instructor progressing from basic flight skills to takeoffs, landings and solo flight! We offer the current year's club membership free with completion of our flight training program.
